PROMULGATION OF ACT OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

The following Act which has been passed by the National Assembly and signed by the President in terms of the Namibian Constitution is hereby published in terms of Article 56 of that Constitution.

No. 2 of 1993: Petroleum (Exploration and Production) Amendment Act, 1993.

**PETROLEUM (EXPLORATION AND
PRODUCTION) AMENDMENT ACT, 1993****ACT**

To amend the Petroleum (Exploration and Production) Act, 1991, so as to provide for agreements to be concluded between the Minister of Mines and Energy and licence holders relating to training programmes and contributions to the Petroleum Training and Education Fund; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

(Signed by the President on 29 March 1993)

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:-

Amendment of section 14
of Act 2 of 1991.

1. Section 14 of the Petroleum (Exploration and Production) Act, 1991, is hereby amended by the addition of the following subsection, the existing section becoming subsection (1):

“(2) The Minister may, for the purposes of paragraph (b) of subsection (1), enter into agreements with licence holders providing for -

- (a) the implementation of training programmes referred to in that paragraph; and
- (b) the contribution of moneys to the trust known as the Petroleum Training and Education Fund, for promoting the objects of that trust.”

Short title.

2. This Act shall be called the Petroleum (Exploration and Production) Amendment Act, 1993.
