Namibian Time Act, 2017

Act 9 of 2017

Published in [Government Gazette no. 6449](#) on 24 October 2017

Assented to on 6 October 2017

ACT

To provide for the standard time of Namibia; and to provide for incidental matters.

BE IT ENACTED as passed by the Parliament, and assented to by the President, of the Republic of Namibia as follows:

1. Standard time of Namibia

The standard time of Namibia is two hours in advance of the Greenwich Mean Time.

2. Repeal of laws

The Namibian Time Act, 1994 (Act [No. 3 of 1994](#)) is repealed.

3. Short title

This Act is called the Namibian Time Act, 2017.
